The Artisjus prize-winning flautist is a soloist and chamber musician at numerous concerts, festivals, charity events and church concerts, where she performs with renowned pianists, orchestras, and various instrumental chamber ensemble formations, at her motherland — Hungary - and throughout Europe. Her studied flutist at the Ferenc Liszt University of Music in Budapest, and then completed his doctorate studies (DLA) at the Faculty of Music of the University of Pécs.

She primarily performs concerts with flute-harp and flute-piano duos, as well as with a string quartet. In addition to fully performing the very wide and rich repertoire of classical flute literature, he considers it important to be open to contemporary music, to introduce and introduce the musical works of our time.
